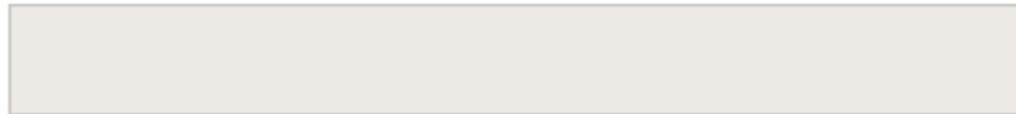

The family will receive friends at his wife's home following the service, in Cary, NC.



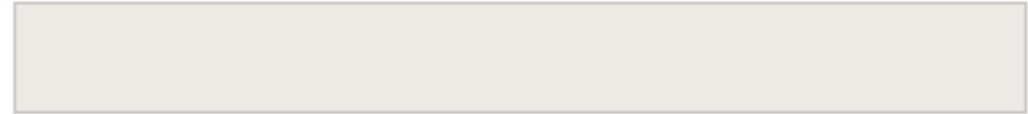
Ronald is preceded in death by his parents, Joseph and Lucille Celentino Howe, and brother,
